Identity Theft

Approximately 15 million United States residents have their identities used fraudulently each year with financial losses totaling upwards of \$50 billion.*

On a case-by-case basis, that means approximately 7% of all adults have their identities misused with each instance resulting in approximately \$3,500 in losses.

Close to 100 million additional Americans have their personal identifying information placed at risk of identity theft each year when records maintained in government and corporate databases are lost or stolen.

These alarming statistics demonstrate identity theft may be the most frequent, costly and pervasive crime in the United States

In a group this size that means 5-7 of us could be a victim of Identity Theft

John 10:10

- o Events in our life steal our true identity
- Most of us are living as a shadow of who we were created to be at best – hiding, pretending – in disguise
- The word of God is your LifeLock to protecting your spiritual identity

Research has shown that memories in our early childhood development effect who we become later in life. Our fears, hang-ups and self image are shaped early on in a child's life.

Many researchers believe the level of popularity a child receives between 2nd and 4th grade is the greatest predictor of the mental health of that person when they become an adult

Not only in childhood but throughout our lives the memories both good and bad can really dictate our future. Our memories really become our future.

Alfred Adler, one of the three great psychologist/philosophers of the twentieth century is said to have started therapy sessions with a question. "What is your earliest memory?" To which he would always answer, "And so life is"

Psychological research suggests that ones self-concept is defined by a very small number of experiences. Only one percent makes it into our conscious memories. And less than one percent would be considered not just memorable but unforgettable.

Every past experience is preparation for some future opportunity. In a sense, who we are today is a combination of the where we've been, what we've done and who we've known
