Philippians 4:13

13 I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. NKJV

- o There is nothing that we face that's to big
- Being in Christ is the key Colossians 2:9

2 Timothy 4:18

18 And the Lord will deliver me from every evil work and preserve me for His heavenly kingdom. To Him be glory forever and ever. Amen! NKJV

1 John 5:4

4 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world — our faith. NKJV

Obstacles

James 1:2

- 2 Consider it wholly joyful, my brethren, whenever you are enveloped in or encounter trials of any sort or fall into various temptations. AMP
 - o Do I pout, quit or blame somebody?
 - o Do I ignore it?
 - Or do I face it and expect a great outcome?
 - Joy Cheerfulness, Calm delight

2 Corinthians 4:17

17 For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory. NKJV

Lessons

Romans 8:37

- 37 Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. NKJV
 - They teach us to be flexible yet determined
 - o Many lessons can only be learned through trials
 - o Experience is a hard teacher
 - o But it will bear fruit

Everywhere

John 16:33

- 33 These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." NKJV
 - We can't get away from them but we can endure and bear good fruit
 - o I am an over comer!

Spiritual Warfare

Patience tells me how I should act

James 1:4

4 So let it grow, and don't try to squirm out of your problems. For when your patience is finally in full bloom, then you will be ready for anything, strong in character, full and complete. TLB

- The truth is that God wants me complete
- o Do I have the persistence I need to see things through?
- Maturity is facing the problem head on
- Accepting responsibility
- Determination to finish the race

Passion helps us handle the pressures of life Acts 20:22-24

22 "And now I am going to Jerusalem, drawn there irresistibly by the Holy Spirit, not knowing what awaits me, 23 except that the Holy Spirit has told me in city after city that jail and suffering lie ahead. 24 But life is worth nothing unless I use it for doing the work assigned me by the Lord Jesus-the work of telling others the Good News about God's mighty kindness and love. TLB

- o Would I know if the Holy Spirit was drawing me?
- o To an area that promised hardship?
- O Would I have the attitude that Paul did?
- My life is worthless unless it is being spent for God's glory

Patience helps us handle the people in our life Colossians 1:11-12

11 strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy; 12 giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. NKJV

- Only the Power of God can give us love for those who challenge or abuse us
- Sometimes we can be hurt by those we love
- o Remember it is Christ who qualifies us
- o Forgive and apply patience

Persistence helps us handle the pain in life Hebrews 10:39

- 39 But we are not of those who draw back to perdition, but of those who believe to the saving of the soul. NKJV
 - We must understand that the things we are facing are the things that can destroy or define us
 - When we give a purpose to our problems we can be assured to have God results
 - o God results lead to a God filled life
 - A God filled life produces kingdom fruit
